Digital and financial literacy sessions were conducted to empower the women holistically. A total of 78 women received training in mobile banking, digital payments, and budgeting. This training equipped them to manage personal and business finances efficiently and significantly enhanced their economic independence.

Tailoring & Garment Making:

Women from secluded and marginalized communities are continually benefiting from Aarohan's tailoring and garment-making projects, which are offered as part of its vocational training sessions.

Through this initiative, women are receiving hands-on training in stitching, pattern making, and garment construction. This process is helping them to become more confident and self-reliant, develop entrepreneurial skills, and Support to their families and communities.

Despite several challenges, Aarohan continues to work closely with the transgender community, focusing on their rights, health, and digital empowerment. Between July and September 2025, Aarohan organized three capacity-building and awareness sessions that addressed health awareness, digital literacy, and access to welfare schemes to enhance knowledge about personal hygiene, mental well-being, and safe healthcare practices while also strengthening digital skills to improve access to online resources and employment opportunities.



Through these collective efforts, over 120 transgender individuals were directly supported with counselling, information, and digital learning exposure. Aarohan remains committed to creating an inclusive, informed, and dignified environment where every transgender person can lead a healthy and empowered life.
