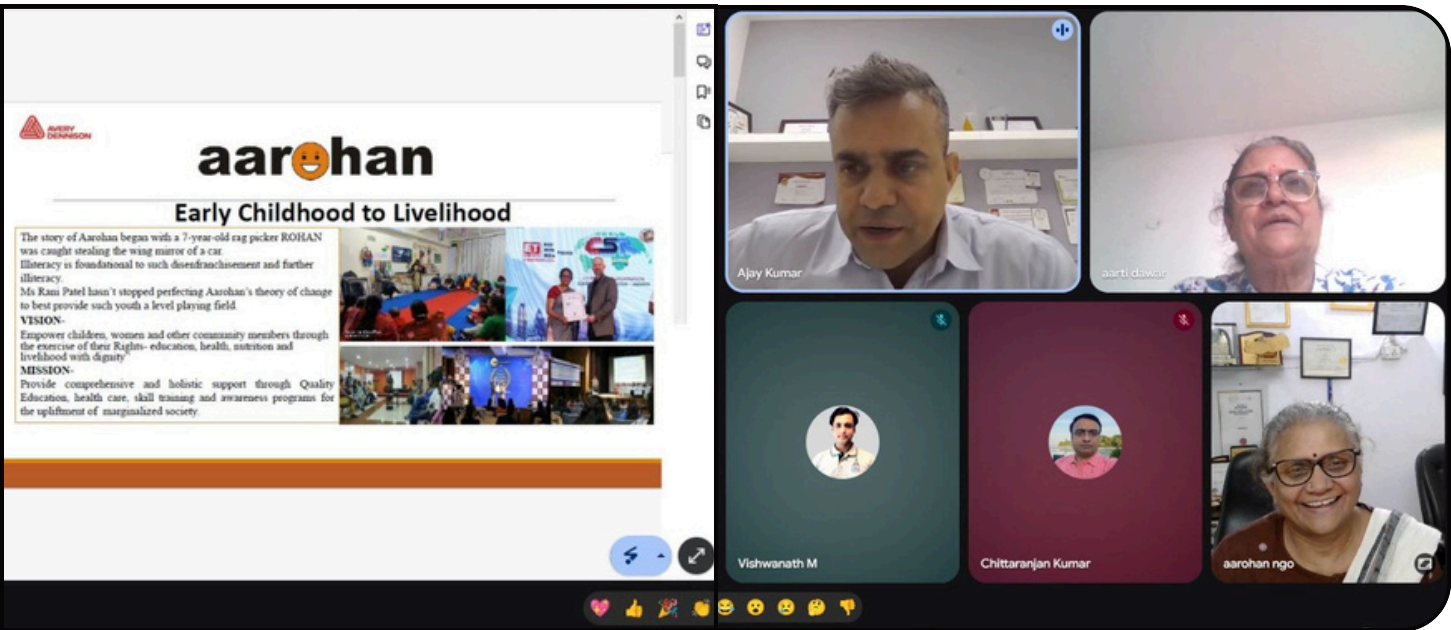
A New Beginning in Madhya Pradesh: Aarohan Strengthens Its National Outreach

With Avery Dennison's support and the collective efforts of partners, communities, and teams, Aarohan proudly marks 20 years of committed service towards education, empowerment, and community development.



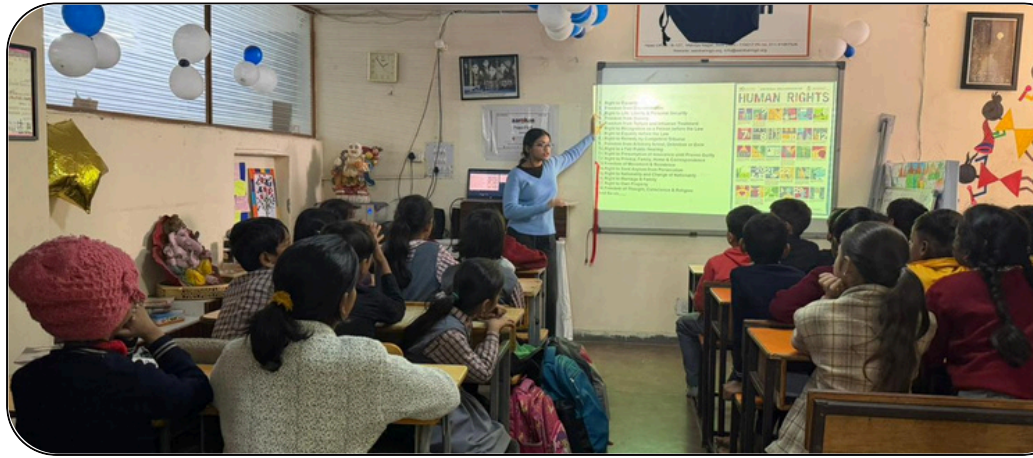
Leadership on the Ground

Her direct interaction with children, families, and adolescent girls helps identify real challenges and guide timely interventions in education, livelihoods, and social inclusion.



EDUCATION

With a focus on holistic and inclusive education, Aarohan supported over 560 children from marginalized communities, including ragpicker families, manual scavengers, and tribal groups. Despite displacement and social challenges, Aarohan ensured continuity of learning and care.



Aarohan ensured access to nutritious food and healthy dietary practices through nutrition support and meal supplementation. Focused efforts helped identify undernutrition and enabled timely interventions, improving children's overall health outcomes.

Through experiential and extracurricular activities, Aarohan nurtured creativity, confidence, teamwork, and social-emotional skills—ensuring holistic development alongside academic learning.



DIGITAL INCLUSION

Computer

Aarohan continued to promote digital inclusion through structured digital learning classes for children from underserved and remote communities. These sessions introduced basic computer skills, enhanced confidence, and improved access to quality education.



STEM Education

STEM education was strengthened through hands-on, activity-based learning in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics. These sessions encouraged curiosity, problem-solving, and logical thinking, helping children understand real-life applications of STEM concepts.

Women Empowerment

Aarohan strengthened livelihood opportunities for 121 women and youth through focused entrepreneurship and skill development initiatives. Participants received hands-on training in business planning, financial literacy, digital tools, and market linkages.
