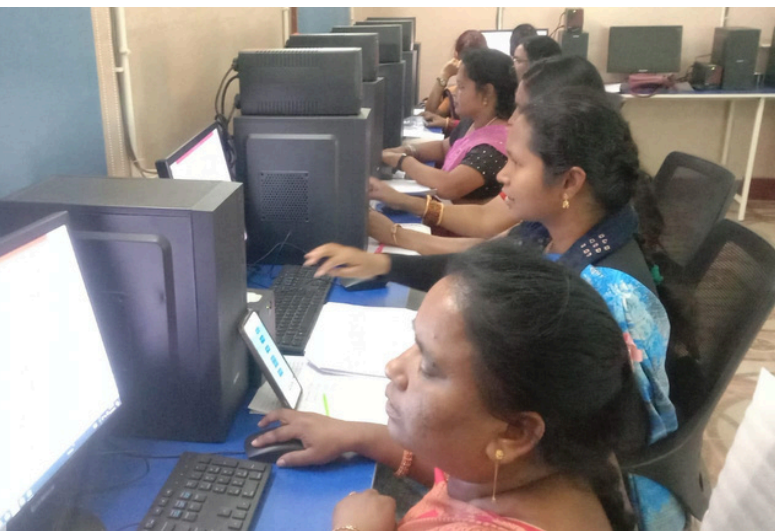
# HIGHLIGHTS OF THE QUARTER

## Health & Nutrition

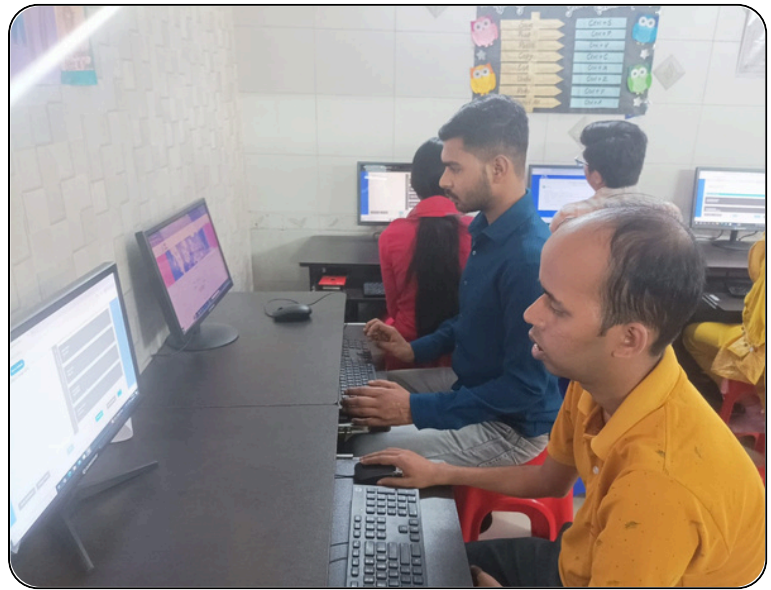
